CHAINS

The soil is rocky clay with some loamy soil along the river bottom. The timber stands are primarily fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, madrone, maple, oak, and chinquapin. The undergrowth is generally light and consists primarily of vine maple, hazel, salal, fern, huckleberry, blackberry, and poison oak.

Numerous occupied dwellings are located along both banks of the river. No mineral deposits were noted.

The average of a number of observations made gives a value of $19^{\circ} 45'$ E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of up to 2° due to local attraction.
