	<p>A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 49 lks. dist., with scribe marks T31S R8W S33 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 75° E., 41 lks. dist., with scribe marks T32S R8W S4 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 23½° W., 20 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.</p> <p>A madrone, 12 ins. diam., bears North, 24 lks. dist., with scribe marks T31S R8W S32 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, pine, cedar, oak, madrone, chinquapin, alder, and maple; undergrowth, poison oak, manzanita, ceanothus, hazel, huckleberry, salal, and Oregon grape.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9. S. 87° 36' W., bet. secs. 5 and 8. Descend 90 ft. over steep rocky W. slope, through light timber and dense undergrowth.</p>

6.90	Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.
