## CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines and boundaries of Donation Land Claims, Numbers 39 and 41, township 22 south, range 7 west, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey, is as follows:

The township boundaries and a portion of the subdivisional lines were surveyed by Harvey Gordon and Charles T. Gardner, in 1855.

Donation Land Claims, Numbers 39 and 41 were surveyed by Dennis Hathorn, in 1858.

A portion of the west boundary of the township was dependently resurveyed by Floyd A. Brooks, in 1963.

A portion of the west boundary, subdivisional lines, and Donation Land Claim boundaries was dependently resurveyed and section 7 was subdivided, by Peter A. Peterson, in 1968.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and Special Instructions, dated February 15, 1977, under Group Number 928, Oregon.

The directions of lines were determined by deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice. Only those lines bounding or crossing public lands were blazed.

The geographic position of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner of sections 19 and 20, as scaled from the Elkton, Oregon, quadrangle map, published by the United States Geological Survey, in 1955, is as follows:

Latitude 43° 38.5' N. Longitude 123° 33.9' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 20° 28' E.
