CHAINS

A sawed fir stump, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 49° E.,
60 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A burned and decayed fir stump, size indeterminate,
bears S. 26° W., 170 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A sawed fir stump, 42 ins. diam., bears N. 11° W.,
70 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and bearing trees mkd. by Brooks

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 75½° E., 56 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 10¼° E., 31 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 23½° W., 53½ lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 78° W., 36½ lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

These control lines were fully retraced and careful
search was made for evidence of intervening corners,
none of which was recovered.

N. 89° 37' E., bet. secs. 18 and 19, marking and blazing
the true line.

Ascend 85 ft. over SW. slope, across open field.

38.06 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 18 and 19, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner. No permanent monument established.

39.85 Wire fence, bears N. and S.

41.33 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 20° E.; asc. 190 ft. over
SW. slope.

52.60 Ridge, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; desc. 85 ft. over
gentle SE. slope, also enter light timber and dense
undergrowth, edge bears N. and S.

68.20 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.

68.64 Intersect the E. bdy. of Donation Land Claim No. 41.

Point for the crossing closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
