Ascend 80 ft. over SW. slope, through scattered timber
and dense undergrowth.

0.20 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears E. and W., also power
transmission line, bears E. and W.

6.70 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 50 ft. over gentle NW.
slope.

30.88 Intersect the line bet. secs. 18 and 19.

The crossing closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, herein-
before described.

From this point, the witness cor. to secs. 17, 18, 19,
and 20, bears N. $89^{\circ} 37'$ E., 4.69 chs. dist., herein-
before described.

Ascend 95 ft. over SE. slope.

31.00 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.

50.00 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 40 ft. over NE. slope.

51.29 The NE. cor. of Claim No. 41, perpetuated and recorded
by Wilford N. Haines, RLS No. 239, in 1967, monumented
with an iron rod, $\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam., firmly set, projecting
12 ins. above ground, from which the remains of an orig-
inal bearing tree:

A root hole, bears S. 25° E., 72 lks. dist., with
a down oak alongside, 15 ins. diam., no marks
visible on decayed blaze.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 38° E., 7 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 36° W., $45\frac{1}{2}$ lks.
dist., with healed blaze.
