

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,
T. 22 S., R. 9 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

from which bearing trees mkd. by Haines

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 64° E., 67 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 56° E., 13 lks. dist., with scribe marks WC S25 CS BT visible on open blaze.

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 60° W., 84 lks. dist., with scribe marks WC T22S R9W S26 CS BT visible on open blaze.

An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 2° W., 11 lks. dist., with scribe marks WC S23 CS BT visible on open blaze.

N. 0° 48' E., bet. secs. 23 and 24, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 50 ft. over SW. slope, through moderate timber and dense undergrowth.

15.25 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 65 ft. over NW. slope.

22.00 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.

34.00 Lutsinger Creek Road, gravelled, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.

38.30 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 24, perpetuated by person(s) unknown, monumented with an iron pipe, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with top mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$. This position has been recognized as the corner since 1947, by Mr. Floyd V. Weatherly, a resident of the area for many years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner position.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, directly over iron pipe, with brass cap mkd.

An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 74° E., 78 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S24 BT.

A maple, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 75° W., 100 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S23 BT.

Corner is located 20 lks. west of the center of Lutsinger Creek Road, gravelled, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 5° E. and S. 5° W.; also, 30 lks. east of Lutsinger Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 40° W.

N. 0° 20' E., beginning new measurement.

Descend 10 ft. along NW. slope, through moderate timber and light undergrowth.
