Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,
T. 22 S., R. 9 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S. 30° E., 26 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 49° W., 100 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on open blaze. (Record, 104 lks.)

Ascend 25 ft. over N. slope.

34.40 Intersect the N. bdy. of sec. 34, and true point for the closing cor. of secs. 27 and 28.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N. 38½° E., 48 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W S27 CC BT.

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N. 61½° W., 65 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W S28 CC BT.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, bears N. 84° 27' W., 7.63 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, alder, cedar, maple, cherry, and chinquapin; undergrowth, blackberry, poison oak, vine Maple, salmonberry, Oregon grape, hazel, blackberry, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.

N. 0° 09' W., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Descend 130 ft. over NE. slope, through moderate timber and undergrowth.

2.60 Ravine, drains E.; desc. 120 ft. over NE. slope.

7.45 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N. 20° W.; desc. 5 ft. over NE. slope.

8.95 Same creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.; thence along meandering creek bed.

14.30 Leave creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 15° W., from S.; asc. 75 ft. over SE. slope.

19.67 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
