	<p>A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 70½° E., 43 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S28 BT.</p> <p>A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 92 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S29 BT.</p> <p>Ascend 250 ft. over NE. slope.</p>
67.20	<p>Ridge, bears N. 75° E. and S. 50° W.; desc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.</p>
71.80	<p>The original closing cor. of secs. 28 and 29, perpetuated by person(s) unknown, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. S28 S29 S33, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:</p> <p>A burned and decayed fir stump, size indeterminate, bears N. 60° E., 63 lks. dist., no marks visible.</p> <p>A sawed fir stump, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 61° W., 12 lks. dist., with scribe marks T2 visible on open blaze.</p> <p>I add marks AM 1974 to brass cap.</p> <p>Descend 5 ft. over SW. slope.</p>

T22S R9W S29 CC BT.</p> <p>No suitable tree available within limits in sec. 28.</p> <p>From this point, the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 only, bears N. 89° 42' W., 5.59 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.</p> <p>From this same point, United States Coast and Geodetic Survey triangulation station "High Pole", bears S. 47° 16' E., 4.48 chs. dist., monumented with a bronze disc, 3½ ins. diam., seated in the top of an iron pipe, 4 ins. diam., firmly set in concrete, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with top mkd. US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY TRIANGULATION STATION HIGH POLE 1953.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay.
