36 lks. dist., with scribe marks T22S S20 visible
on bark blaze. (Record, 34 lks.)

A decayed fir snag, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W.,
55 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and bearing trees mkd. by Lewis

A maple, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 32° E., 50 lks.
dist., no marks visible.

A hemlock, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 50° E., 10½ lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 14° W., 45 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Godfrey

A hemlock, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 32° W., 65
lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible
on partially healed blaze.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, and maple; undergrowth,
poison oak, Oregon grape, salal, scotch broom, hazel, and
salmonberry.

From the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22.

S. 88° 32' W., bet. secs. 16 and 21.

Descend 80 ft. over SW. slope, through moderate timber
and undergrowth.

- 1.30 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. and S. 30° E., in curve.
- 3.60 Ravine, drains N. 50° W.; desc. 25 ft. over NW. slope.
- 6.40 Ravine, drains S. 70° W.; desc. 5 ft. along S. slope.
- 28.10 Ravine, drains S. 35° W.; asc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.
- 30.80 Spur, slopes S. 15° W.; desc. 280 ft. over SW. slope.
- 37.35 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 55° W.; asc. 130 ft. over
NE. slope.
- 40.52 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, determined from the
remains of the original bearing trees:

A fir stump, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 23½° E., 29
lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on
opened blaze. (Record, N. 20° E.)
