	Ascend 95 ft. over SE. slope.
14.40	Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 70 ft. over NW. slope.
17.30	Ravine, drains N.; asc. 155 ft. over E. slope.
20.80	Paved road, 25 lks. wide, on top of ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 345 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
29.10	Ravine, drains NW.; desc. 10 ft. along S. slope.
30.15	Dry creek bed, 4 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 95 ft. over NE. slope.
33.60	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.
35.10	Ravine, drains N. 20° E.; asc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.
37.90	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 55 ft. over NW. slope.
39.33	The cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

	A cedar, 35 ins. diam., bears N. 25° W., 30 lks. dist., no marks visible on open decayed blaze.

	A fir snag, 72 ins. diam., bears N. 4° E., 109 lks. dist., with scribe marks T19S R7W S35 B visible on open decayed blaze.
	A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 33° W., 72 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
	and a new bearing tree
	A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 37½° E., 87 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R7W S35 BT.
	Set a 5 ft. steel fence post alongside iron post.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrone, and dogwood; undergrowth, ceanothus, manzanita, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, huckleberry, poison oak, Oregon grape, salal, and fern.
	N. 89° 34' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 34.
	Descend 245 ft. over broken NW. slope, through medium timber and dense undergrowth.
5.50	Paved road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.
