28.40	<p>Head of ravine, drains SE.; asc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.</p>
29.40	<p>Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 3 only, T. 20 S., R. 7 W. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
