	<p>No suitable trees available within limits.</p> <p>Set a 5 ft. steel fence post alongside brass tablet.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with sandstone outcroppings. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrone, and dogwood; undergrowth, ceanothus, manzanita, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, poison oak, Oregon grape, salal, and fern.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 only, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T 19 S R 7 W S 32 S 33 T 20 S R 7 W S 4 1949</p> <p>from which the remains of the original bearing trees</p> <p>A sawed fir stump, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 15° W., 44 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, 41 lks.)</p> <p>A sawed fir stump, 52 ins. diam., bears N. 26° W., 14 lks. dist., with healed blaze.</p> <p>No suitable trees available within limits.</p> <p>Set a 5 ft. steel fence post alongside iron post.</p> <p>N. 89° 58' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 32.</p> <p>Descend 100 ft. over NW. slope, across Oxbow Burn through dense undergrowth.</p>
4.20	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 180 ft. over NE. slope.
8.29	True point for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, T. 20 S R. 7 W., hereinafter described.
10.00	Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 230 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
21.45	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.
22.40	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 5 ft. over NW. slope.
23.00	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N. 15° E.; asc. 125 ft. over E. slope.
26.30	Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 35° W., in curve, also leave Oxbow Burn, enter timber, edge bears N. 80° E. and S. 35° W.
27.50	Ridge. bears N. and S.; desc. 255 ft. over steep W. slope.
31.90	Ravine, drains NW.; desc. 170 ft. along N. slope, changing to NW. slope.
