| | S. 89° 03' W., beginning new measurement. Descend 55 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 5.10 | Ravine, drains S. 10° E.; asc. 160 ft. over SE. slope. |
| 7.80 | Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 5° W., in curve. |
| 10.20 | Spur, slopes S. 20° E.; desc. 60 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 17.10 | Bottom of descent, slopes SE.; asc. 55 ft. over SE. slope. |
| 21.80 | Gravelled road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W., also enter Oxbow Burn, edge bears same as road. |
| 23.80 | Ridge, bears N. 50° E. and S. 80° W.; asc. 40 ft. along N. slope. |
| 28.00 | Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 10° W. and S. 30° E. |
| 29.50 | Ridge, bears S. 80° E., S. 50° W., and N. 10° W.; desc. 95 ft. over NW. slope. |
| 32.10 | Ravine, drains N. 15° W.; asc. 20 ft. over NE. slope. |
| 35.60 | Spur, slopes N. 40° W.; desc. 140 ft. over W. slope, changing to NW. slope. |
| 39.50 | The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14, and 15. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin, and madrone; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, manzanita, ceanothus, huckleberry, blackberry, Oregon grape, salal, and fern. |
| | N. 0° 27' E., bet. secs. 10 and 11. Descend 60 ft. over NW. slope, through dense undergrowth, across Oxbow Burn. |
| 5.10 | Spur, slopes N. 40° W.; desc. 120 ft. over NE. slope. |
| 9.40 | Ravine, drains N. 55° W.; asc. 260 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 21.10 | Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope. |
| 26.10 | Ravine, drains N. 80° W.; asc. 75 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 32.20 | Spur ridge, bears N. 5° W. and S. 15° E.; desc. 130 ft. over NE. slope. |
| 37.40 | Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 60° E., in curve. |
| 39.36 | Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 11, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. |
