0.25	Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N. 55° W.; asc. 325 ft. over NE. slope.
13.85	Ridge bears N. 40° W. and S. 40° E.; desc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
16.40	Head of ravine, drains N. 75° W.; asc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.
18.80	Ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 45 ft. over SW. slope.

1.60	Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.
3.20	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 80° W.; asc. 305 ft. over broken S. slope.
14.25	Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 45° W. and S. 50° E.
15.15	Spur, slopes S. 45° W.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.
15.80	Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 30° W.
