

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,
T. 23 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $65\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 355 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S32 BT visible on open blaze.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 85° W., 235 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT visible on open blaze.

From this same point, the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., bears N. $89^{\circ} 34'$ W., 82.17 chs. dist., determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing tree:

A madrone stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 45° W., 5 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on open blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A madrone, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 29 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R4W S30 BT on bark.

A black oak, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 53° W., 29 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R5W S36 BT on bark.

A madrone, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 53° W., 2 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R5W S25 BT on bark.

No other suitable trees available within limits.

Search was made for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31, no evidence of which was found.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, myrtle, madrone, and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, rhododendron, vine maple, poison oak, hazel, Oregon grape, and fern.

N. $0^{\circ} 28'$ E., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Descend 75 ft. over NW. slope, through scattered timber and dense undergrowth.

1.20 Bachelor Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 75° W.; curving S.; asc. 325 ft. over SW. slope.

6.15 Gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 75° E. and S. 80° W.

17.75 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.

19.94 Point for the S $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 30.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
