CHAINS

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 49° W., 45 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R8W S23 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 50½° W., 15½ lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R8W S14 BT.

No suitable tree available within limits in sec. 24.

From this point, a cor. established by Dennis Crowe,
Registered Land Surveyor No. 845, in 1972, bears
S. 32° 02' E., 0.20 chs. dist., monumented with an iron
post, 1½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above
ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on partially open blaze.

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 3° E., 43½ lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A madrone, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 48½° W., 3 lks.
dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on
open blaze.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 35° W., 15 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, alder, myrtle,
and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, vine maple, poison
oak, rhododendron, Oregon grape, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, on the E. bdy.
of the Tp., reestablished at proportionate distance and
recorded by Howard Johnstone, Registered Land Surveyor
No. 498, in 1977, and is accepted as the best available
evidence of the position of the original corner, monu-
mented with an iron rod, 5/8 in. diam., firmly set, pro-
jecting 8 ins. above ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
