The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 14, perpetuated and recorded by James W. Byron, County Surveyor, in 1967, monumented with an iron post, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 9 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A root hole, bears East, 26 lks. dist., with a down fir alongside, 20 ins. diam., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on bark blaze.

and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Byron

A root hole, bears N. 50° E., $14\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with a down fir alongside, 8 ins. diam., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A root hole, bears N. 36° W., 23 lks. dist., with a down cedar alongside, 6 ins. diam., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

and new bearing trees

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 41° E., $30\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S13 BT.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 14° W., $41\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, live oak, myrtle, madrone, alder, and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, vine maple, rhododendron, poison oak, Oregon grape, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. $0^\circ 16'$ W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Descend 90 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

3.95 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 50° E.; asc. 300 ft. over broken SE. slope.

21.05 Top of ascent, slopes E.; desc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.

23.75 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 135 ft. over broken SE. slope.

35.50 Spur, slopes S. 50° E.; desc. 145 ft. over NE. slope.

38.75 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
