CHAINS

from which

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 29° E., 20 lks.
dist., mkd. ½ S35 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 71° W., 23½ lks.
dist., mkd. ½ S34 BT.

Descend 380 ft. over NE. slope.

- 56.40 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course E.; desc. 50 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 65.90 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.
- 72.20 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 105 ft. over N. slope.
- 75.95 Dutchman Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 50° E.; asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.
- 77.50 Point for the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 51¼° W., 101 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R8W S34 BT.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 61¼° W., 25 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R8W S27 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, live oak, myrtle, alder, madrone, and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, vine maple, rhododendron, poison oak, Oregon grape, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.

S. 89° 01' W., bet. secs. 26 and 35.

Descend 240 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 7.90 Ravine, drains N. 65° W.; desc. 65 ft. over NW. slope.
- 10.95 Bottom of descent, slopes N.; asc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.
- 14.10 Spur, slopes N. 35° W.; desc. 155 ft. over NW. slope.
