	A madrone, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 40° W., 36½ lks. dist., with scribe marks N 1/16 S24 BT visible on opened blaze.
	and a bearing tree mkd. by Popken and Carlson, and redescribed by Smith
	A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 77° E., 25½ lks. dist., with scribe marks N 1/16 S19 BT visible on partially healed blaze.
	From this point, the N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, erroneously established by Popken and Carlson, in 1976, bears S. 73° W., 0.07 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record of the 1975-76 resurvey.
	I remove the iron post, and destroy the scribe marks on the NW. bearing tree.
	N. 0° 12' E., beginning new measurement.
	Ascend 55 ft. over SE. slope.

	A madrone root crown in center of a clump of madrone, size indeterminate, bears N. 81° E., 30 lks. dist. (Record, N. 85° E.)
	The center of a madrone clump, bears S. 15° E., 56½ lks. dist. (Record, S. 30° E., 61 lks. and slope dist.)
	A ponderosa pine snag, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 91½ lks. dist., no marks visible. This tree has been chopped and sawed into the center, destroying any possibility of finding an original blaze. (Record, and slope dist., 100 lks.)
	A live oak clump, bears N. 45° W., 31 lks. dist.
	and bearing trees mkd. or redescribed by Smith
