A root hole, bears S. 8° E., 18 lks. dist., with a down fir alongside, 40 ins. diam., no marks visible.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears N. 63° W., 71 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Powell

A fir snag, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 72° E., 141½ lks. dist., with scribe marks T32S R6W S7 CS BT visible on open double blaze.

A fir, 31 ins. diam., bears S. 85° E., 58½ lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 87½ lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Popken and Carlson

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 69½° E., 96 lks. dist., with scribe marks T32S R6W S7 BT visible on open blaze.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay, with rock outcroppings S½ mile.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar, oak, madrone, and dogwood; undergrowth, manzanita, poison oak, hazel, arrowwood, fern, salal, and young timber.

From the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

S. 86° 36' W., bet. secs. 13 and 24.

Ascend 310 ft. over rocky SE. slope, through light timber and dense undergrowth.

12.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S. 40° E.; asc. 80-ft. over SE. slope.

17.15 Spur ridge, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

19.29 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24.

From this point, the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, erroneously established by Popken and Carlson, in 1976, bears S. 3° 08' W., 0.27 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record of the 1975-76 resurvey.
