Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,
T. 30 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

and bearing trees mkd. by Byron

A cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 32° E., 19 lks. dist., with scribe marks T30S R7W S35 CS BT visible on open blaze.

A pine, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 27° E., 13 lks. dist., with scribe marks T31S R7W S2 CS BT visible on open blaze.

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 1½° W., 71 lks. dist., with scribe marks 31 CS visible on open blaze.

N. 0° 03' E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Descend 470 ft. over NW. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

20.245 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A pine, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 15½° E., 42 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S35 BT.

A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 14¾° W., 49½ lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S34 BT.

Descend 100 ft. over NW. slope.

21.75 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.

30.75 Same road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 50° W. and S. 50° E.

31.60 Ravine, drains N. 25° W.; asc. 5 ft. over SW. slope.

32.80 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.

34.40 Ravine, drains N. 70° W.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

39.85 Spur, slopes N. 70° W.; desc. 2 ft. over NW. slope.

40.49 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, perpetuated and recorded by Norman D. Price, Registered Land Surveyor No. 33, in 1953, and further perpetuated by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1962, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with a bronze washer on top, mkd. RS 33, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A pine, 35 ins. diam., bears N. 85° E., 75 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A root hole, bears S. 80° W., 125 lks. dist., with a down pine alongside, 36 ins. diam., no marks visible.
