CHAINS

The area is drained by Cow Creek and Island Creek and their tributaries. The soil is a rocky clay loam. Timber consists of fir, hemlock, pine, cedar, alder, oak, and madrone, with undergrowth of vine maple, rhododendron, hazel, poison oak, salal, Oregon grape, and fern.

Access is gained by way of an asphalt surfaced road from Riddle along Cow Creek and a number of logging roads extending from it into the area.

There were no mineral deposits noted in the area.

The average of a considerable number of readings gives a value of $18^{\circ} 22'$ E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 2° in local attraction.
