	<p>A sawed fir stump, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 63$\frac{3}{4}$° E., 29$\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on burned bark blaze. (Record, S. 58° E., 28 lks.)</p> <p>A cedar, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 70° W., 8 lks. dist., no marks visible on open decayed blaze. This tree was rescribed by Powell, with scribe marks T33S R7W S3 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>and bearing trees mkd. by Powell</p> <p>A fir, 33 ins. diam., bears N. 3° E., 134 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on pitched over blaze.</p> <p>A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 89$\frac{1}{2}$° E., 20 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on pitched over blaze.</p> <p>No suitable tree available in sec. 10.</p> <p>N. 0° 08' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3, marking and blazing the true line.</p> <p>Descend 15 ft. over NW. slope, through scattered timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
1.90	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 10° E.; asc. 75 ft. along E. slope.
3.40	Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. and S. 30° E., in curve, thence along road.
12.50	Creek under road, 1 lk. wide, course S. 65° E.; continue ascent.
13.20	Leave road, bears N. 40° E. and S., in curve.
14.45	Spur, slopes N. 60° E.; desc. 260 ft. over N. slope.
15.25	Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 75° W. and S. 50° E., in curve.
27.40	Wet ravine, drains N.; continue descent over N. slope.
30.00	Leave ravine, drains N. 10° W.; continue descent over N. slope.
36.40	Perkins Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 60° E.; asc. 90 ft. over SE. slope.
38.55	Water ditch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 20° E.
40.76	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, perpetuated and recorded by H. W. Lawrence, Registered Engineer No. 1543, in 1967, monumented with an iron pipe, $\frac{3}{4}$ in. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, with metal tag mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1543, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:</p> <p>A sawed and decayed fir stump, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 40° E., 47 lks. dist., no marks visible.</p> <p>A root hole, bears N. 33° W., 38 lks. dist., with a down and decayed fir alongside, size indeterminate, with scribe mark S visible on open blaze.</p>
