30.40	Enter swampy area, created by beaver dams, edge bears SE. and NW.	
36.80	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32, at proportionate distance, there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T 19 S R 10 W ¼ $\frac{S\ 32}{S\ 5}$ T 20 S 1979</p> <p>from which</p> <p>An alder, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 4° E., 56 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S32 BT on bark.</p> <p>A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S. 78½° W., 158 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S5 BT.</p> <p>From this point, a locally established corner, bears N. 89° 57' W., 1.50 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, from which a locally mkd. bearing tree:</p> <p>A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S. 8½° W., 33 lks. dist., with healed blaze.</p> <p>Continue across nearly level swampy area.</p>	
37.35	Leave swampy area, edge bears N. and S.; asc. 275 ft. over NE. slope, along original blazed line.	
55.20	<p>Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">W 1/16 $\frac{S\ 32}{S\ 5}$ 1979</p> <p>from which</p> <p>An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears North, 39 lks. dist., mkd.
