	<p>A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 25° W., 30 lks. dist., with healed blaze.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay. Timber, fir, alder, maple, cedar, hemlock, and cascara; undergrowth, young timber, vine maple, salmonberry, rhododendron, huckleberry, salal, arrowwood, Oregon grape, elderberry, thimbleberry, and fern.</p>
	<p>N. 89° 26' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.</p> <p>Descend 50 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
2.00	Head of ravine, drains S.; asc. 75 ft. over SE. slope.
4.00	Spur, slopes S. 25° W.; desc. 140 ft. over W. slope.
9.15	Ravine, drains S. 15° E.; asc. 285 ft. over NE. slope.
16.50	Spur, slopes S.; desc. 360 ft. over broken W. slope.
28.05	Ravine, drains S. 10° E.; asc. 335 ft. over E. slope.
36.89	<p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with the original unmarked decomposing sandstone, 9 x 8 x 5 ins., firmly set 4 ins. in the ground and in a scattering mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 6 ins. high. This corner position is further substantiated by a number of blazed trees located along the W½ mile bet. secs. 5 and 32, and the E½ mile bet. secs. 6 and 31, several of which were opened, with overgrowth dating to the time of the original survey.
