Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,
T. 32 S., R. 6 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

From this point, a locally established corner of which I have no record, bears N. $78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 0.395 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 18 ins. above ground.

Land, rolling.

Soil, clay loam.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar, oak, madrone, alder, ash, and willow: undergrowth, poison oak, wild rose, blackberry, and fir and pine reproduction.

From the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27, perpetuated and recorded by H. W. Lawrence, Registered Engineer No. 1543, in 1950-51, from original evidence no longer in existence, and further perpetuated and recorded by Lawrence, in 1963, monumented with a galvanized iron pipe $\frac{3}{4}$ in. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with lead cap mkd. 22 23 26 27 1543.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 84 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R6W S23 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 44° E., 120 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R6W S26 BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. $81\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 106 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R6W S27 BT.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. $44\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 70 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R6W S22 BT.

Reset iron pipe alongside iron post.

From this point, a corner reported by Lawrence, in 1950-51, bears S. $25\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 0.335 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground.

Corner is located under a 3 strand power transmission line, bears N. 57° E. and S. 57° W.

N. $89^{\circ} 22'$ W., bet. secs. 22 and 27.

Descend 90 ft. over NW. slope, through medium timber and light undergrowth.

5.10 Road, asphalt surfaced, 50 lks. wide, bears N. 50° E. and S. 50° W.

8.25 Power and telephone line, bears NE. and SW.

11.10 Windy Creek, 15 lks. wide, course S. 45° W.; asc. 5 ft. over nearly level open pasture land.
