CHAINS

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 85° W., 20 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 38° W., 11 lks.
dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on open blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 66° E., 19½ lks.
dist., mkd. T25S R1W S21 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, alder, and
chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, rhododendron, Oregon
grape, poison oak, vine maple, and fern.

From the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, perpetuated and
recorded by Bruce A. Shaner, Registered Engineer No. 4906,
in 1967, monumented with the remains of the original
corner tree, a chinquapin root crown, 4 ins. diam., from
which the remains of an original bearing tree:

A chinquapin root crown, 6 ins. diam., bears
N. 28° E., 22 lks. dist., no marks visible.
(Record, 19 lks.)

and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Shaner

A sawed fir stump, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 49° W.,
22½ lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks
visible on open blaze.

A sawed fir stump, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 19½° W.,
52½ lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S9 BT visible
on open blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

No suitable trees available within limits.

From this point, a corner established by Thomas E. Shrum,
Jr., Registered Engineer No. 4287, in 1966, and perpetu-
ated by Vernon R. Tracy, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1966,
bears N. 81½° W., 1.00 chs. dist., determined from the
remains of bearing trees mkd. by Shrum:

A cedar snag, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 31° E., 14
lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on open blaze.

A chinquapin, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 41° E., 21
lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on open blaze.

A chinquapin, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 31½
lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on open blaze.
