A trench, from which the southerly end bears N. 87° 14' E., 907.00 ft. from cor. No. 1, averaging 7 ft. in width, 6 ft. deep, running N. 44° W., 30 ft.

A trench, from which the southerly end bears N. 84° 53' E., 1018.50 ft. from cor. No. 1, averaging 10 ft. in width, 6 ft. deep, running N. 34° W., 59 ft.

 thence S. 50° 18' E., 55.42 ft. to Sta. No. 4;
 thence S. 61° 47' E., 55.04 ft. to Sta. No. 5
 and terminus. From Sta. No. 1 to Sta. No. 2, the approximate size 23.5 ft. wide and 17.5 ft. deep; Sta. No. 2 to Sta. No. 3 is approximately 19 ft. wide, 8.5 ft. deep; Sta. No. 3 to Sta. No. 5 is approximately 18 ft. wide, 7 ft. deep.
