CHAINS

- (C) Character and position of mining operation has been previously stated under improvements.

## TRADE CENTER

- (D) Proximity of center of trade is the city of Myrtle Creek with a population of 3,230 people. By road is southwesterly 13 miles.

- (E) Known lodes now abandoned approximately one-quarter of a mile westerly.

## ADAPTABILITY OF CLAIM

- (F) Along Myrtle Creek, early mining relates to about the year 1870, with considerable mining on the Star Placer Claim in the early part of the 1960's; there are large quantities of water in Myrtle Creek available.

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

A wood frame house, the SW. cor. of which bears S. 64° 06' W., 317.11 ft. from cor. No. 3 20.4 x 39.75 ft. in size, long side bears N. 8° W., having a wing at the NE. corner, 12 x 13.1 ft. in size, with a car port attached to south side of wing, 12 x 23.3 ft. in size.
