CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary, township 23 south, range 4 west, and portion of the south boundary, subdivisional lines, and claim lines, and the subdivision of section 15, township 24 south, range 4 west.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey, is as follows:

The south boundary, and a portion of the north boundary and subdivisional lines of township 24 south, range 4 west, were surveyed by Harvey Gordon and Charles Gardner, in 1855.

The boundaries of Donation Land Claim No. 46, in township 24 south, range 4 west, were surveyed by Dennis Hathorn, in 1856.

A portion of the subdivisional lines of township 24 south, range 4 west, was surveyed by Oscar Thiel, in 1896-97.

Certain original corner points in township 24 south, range 4 west were remonumented without survey by C. Albert White and Norman J. McDonald, in 1963.

A portion of the south boundary of township 23 south, range 4 west, was resurveyed by James E. Jelley, in 1976.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, the Special Instructions dated April 19, 1979, and Supplemental Special Instructions dated July 3, 1979, under Group Number 979, Oregon.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes were give herein. Only those lines bounding or crossing public lands were blazed. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the south boundary of the township, as scaled from the Glide, Oregon, quadrangle map, published by the United States Geological Survey, in 1954, is as follows:

Latitude 43° 25.9' N. Longitude 123° 10.0' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 19° 30' E.
