- 9.20 Ravine, drains N. 30° W.; asc. 145 ft. over NE slope.
- 16.35 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 40 ft. over NW slope.
- 20.40 Ravine, drains N.; desc. 10 ft. over NE slope.
- 21.15 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 50 ft. over NW slope.
- 22.65 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 45 ft. over NE slope.
- 24.40 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 30 ft. over NW slope.
- 26.30 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 65 ft. over NE slope.
- 30.50 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 175 ft. over broken NW slope.
- 39.60 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of an original bearing tree;

An oak stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 45° W., 53 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT in reverse and relief visible on overgrowth.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A white oak, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 54° W., 50 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S29 BT.

S. 89° 38' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 95 ft. over NW slope.

- 15.10 Creek, 1 lk wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 35 ft. over NE slope
- 17.15 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 40 ft. over NW slope
- 27.35 Oldham Creek, 10 lks. wide, course S. 15° W.; asc. 5 ft. over nearly level land.
- 38.50 Concrete bridge over Oldham Creek, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E., and S. 65° W., creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 25° W.
- 40.21 The cor. of secs. ~~10~~¹⁹, 20, 29, and 30.
