A root hole, bears N. 30° E., 9 lks. dist., with
a down hemlock alongside, 5 ins. diam., with
fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A root hole, bears S. 41° W., 16 1/2 lks. dist., with
a down hemlock alongside, 5 ins. diam., with
fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

At the corner point

Reset the county iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 1/4 ins. diam.,
28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 86° E., 20 lks.
dist., mkd. 1/4 S14 BT.

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 14 1/2° W., 35 lks.
dist., mkd. 1/4 S15 BT.

The position for the county corner monument had changed
since 1962, because of a small land slide which necessi-
tated resetting the monument.

The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14, and 15, perpetuated and re-
corded by Wilford Haines, Registered Land Surveyor No. 239,
in 1961, and further perpetuated and recorded by Milo
Godfrey, Depty County Surveyor, in 1962, monumented
with a T shaped iron rod, 1 in. cross section, firmly set,
projecting 10 ins. above ground, from which the remains
of the original bearing trees:

A root hole, bears N. 45° E., 59 lks. dist., with
a down fir alongside, 53 ins. diam., no marks
visible.

A cedar, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 29° E., 32 lks.
dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on open original blaze, and healed blaze by
Godfrey.

A root hole, bears S. 84° W., 45 lks. dist., with
a down fir alongside, 50 ins. diam., no marks
visible.

A cedar snag, 33 ins. diam., bears N. 56° W., 9
lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible
on open blaze.
