CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which a new bearing tree

A hemlock, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 8° E., 34 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

Reset T shaped iron rod alongside iron post.

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 27, perpetuated and recorded by Wilford Haines, Registered Land Surveyor No. 239, in 1960, monumented with a T shaped iron rod, 1 in. cross section, firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A sawed fir stump, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 50 1/2° W., 19 lks. dist., with healed original blaze and scribe marks 1/4 S22 BT. visible by Haines on bark blaze. (Record, N. 45° W.)

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears S. 50 1/2° E., 23 lks. dist., with healed original blaze and scribe marks 1/4 S27 BT visible by Haines on bark blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 4° W., 140 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S22 BT.

Reset T shaped iron rod alongside iron post.

The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32, perpetuated and recorded by Wilford Haines, Registered Land Surveyor No. 239, in 1960, and further perpetuated and recorded by Milo Godfrey, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1961, monumented with a T shaped iron rod, 1 in. cross section, firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, from which the remaining original bearing tree:

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 85° W., 42 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially open original blaze and healed blaze by Godfrey.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 68° E., 58 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A hemlock, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 68° E., 41 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
