12.30	Spur ridge, bears N. 40° E. and S. 20° W.: desc. 190 ft. over SW. slope
19.25	Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, T. 33 S., R. 4 W., described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 33 S., R. 4 W., executed concurrently under this same group. Descend 2 ft. over creek bank.
19.55	Dry creek bed, 3 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 15 ft. over SE. slope.
21.25	Wet ravine, drains SE.; asc. 100 ft. over E. slope. Ascend 245 ft. over SE. slope.

Timber, fir, cedar, pine, madrone, chinquapin, alder, yew, maple, and hemlock; undergrowth, manzanita, vine maple, ceanothus, rhododendron, poison oak, salal, Oregon grape, fern, and young timber.</p> <hr/> <div style="margin-left: 40px;">S. 89° 37' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 36.</div> <div style="margin-left: 40px;">Ascend 55 ft. over SE. slope, through moderate timber and undergrowth, along S. edge of logged area.</div>

13.35	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. from NE; asc. 185 ft. over SE. slope
