(Seventh Standard Parallel South),
T. 32 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 44 1/2° W., 17 lks. dist., with scribe marks R4W S visible on partially opened blaze. (Record, N. 40° W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Timber, fir, cedar, pine, madrone, chinquapin, alder, yew, maple, and hemlock; undergrowth, manzanita, ceanothus, vine maple, rhododendron, poison oak, salal, Oregon grape, fern, and young timber.

S. 89° 31' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 35.

Descend 85 ft. over W. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth, across partially logged area.

6.95 Graves Creek, 10 lks. wide, course S. 40° W.; asc. 250 ft. over SE. slope.

8.25 Graves Creek Road, asphalt surfaced, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 20° W., in curve.

23.365 True point for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 33 S., R. 4 W., described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 33 S., R. 4 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

Ascend 105 ft. over SE. slope.

28.475 True point for the closing cor. of secs. 34 and 35, hereinafter described.

Thence N. 89° 31' W., continue measurement on the S. bdy of sec. 34.

Ascend 180 ft. over SE. slope, changing to E. slope of spur.

38.80 Gravelled road, 30 lks. wide, bears NW. and SW., in curve,

39.32 The former standard 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 34, changed to an angle point by Chapman and Nicklin, monumented with a basalt stone, 12 x 8 x 8 ins. firmly set 6 ins. in the ground, mkd. SC 1/4 on N. face, from which the remains of an original bearing tree:

A root hole, bears N. 45° W., 14 lks. dist.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
