Corrective Dependent Resurvey of a Portion
of the North Boundary,
T. 30 S., R. 6 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

N. 89° 26' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 4, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 5 ft. over broken NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

7.65 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 195 ft. over NE. slope.

30.40 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope.

37.30 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 25 ft. over NE. slope.

38.54 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 33 only, T. 29 S., R. 6 W., at midpoint on the S. bdy. of sec. 33.

From this point, the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 33 only, erroneously established by Thielsen and White, in 1958-59, bears S. 52° 13' W., 0.15 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official record.

I remove the iron post, and at the corner point

Reset the iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 33 1/2° E., 41 1/2 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 45 1/4° W., 46 1/2 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

Ascend 45 ft. over NE. slope.

44.17 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 4 only, T. 30 S., R. 6 W., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

From this point, the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 4 only, erroneously reestablished by Thielsen and White, in 1958-59, bears S. 4° 50' E., 0.06 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official record.

I remove the iron post, and at the corner point

Reset the iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
