**CHAINS**

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, maple, oak, madrone, and chinquapin; undergrowth, poison oak, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, blackberry, fern, Oregon grape, wild rose, and young timber.

N. 89° 02' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 5.

Ascend 230 ft. over NE. slope, through moderate timber and dense undergrowth.

15.20 Saddle in ridge, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; asc. 5 ft. along S slope.

15.60 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.

19.35 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 5 only.

From this point, the E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 5 only erroneously established by Thielsen and White, on 1958-59, bears West, 0.26 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official record.

I remove the iron post, and at the corner point

Reset the iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 21 1/2° E., 205 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A cedar, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 38 1/2° W., 227 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

Ascend 60 ft. over SE. slope.

20.90 Dirt road, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.

25.10 Spur, slopes S. 45° W.; desc. 115 ft. over NW. slope.

27.70 From this point, the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, T. 29 S., R. 6 W., erroneously established by Thielsen and White, in 1958, bears North, 0.03 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official record.

I remove the iron post and destroy the marks on the bearing tree.

37.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S. 70° W.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.

38.70 The 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 5 only, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
