

	<p>from which</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 51 1/2° E., 53 lks. dist., mkd. MS 234 RR6 BT.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A cedar, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 72 3/4° W., 88 lks. dist., mkd. MS 234 RR6 BT.</p>
	<p>N. 55° 30' E., on line, 6-7 of Ruth Ruble Placer, Mineral Survey No. 234.</p> <p>Ascend 10 ft. along gentle NW. slope, through placer tailings.</p>
5.70	Foot of mountain, leave placer tailings, edge bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.; asc. 40 ft. along NW. slope, through young timber and dense undergrowth.
8.50	Top of ascent, slopes NW.; desc. 5 ft. along NW. slope.
11.225	Intersect the line bet. secs. 28 and 29.
	<p>The crossing closing cor. of secs. 28 and 29 with line 6-7 of Ruth Ruble Placer, hereinbefore described.</p> <p>From this point, the cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29, bears N. 0° 15' E., 19.305 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.</p> <p>Descend 10 ft. over N. slope.</p>
12.00	Coyote Creek, 10 lks. wide, course S. 60° W., turning W.; asc. 3 ft. along creek.
12.755	Intersect line 1-2 of Horseshoe Lode, Mineral Survey No. 840, located in Coyote Creek, where it is impracticable to establish a permanent monument.
	<p>From this point, the original witness cor. to cor. No. 2, Horseshoe Lode, bears S. 34° 21' E., 0.15 chs. dist., hereinafter described.</p> <p>Continue along Coyote Creek</p>
13.25	Leave Coyote Creek, 10 lks. wide, course S. 60° W. from NE.; asc. 70 ft. along NW. slope.
20.70	Top of ascent, slopes NW.; desc. 10 ft. over N. slope.
22.845	From this point, a corner established and recorded by R. L. Templin, Jr., Registered Engineer No. 3024, in 1975, bears S. 34° 30' E., 0.395 chs. dist., monumented with an iron rod, 5/8 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with plastic cap mkd. TEMPLIN RE 3024.
23.00	Scholey Gulch, 1 lk. wide course N. 60° W.; asc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.
23.60	Abandoned dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 35° W. and S. 35° E.
