**CHAINS**

27.60 Top of ascent, slopes NW.; desc. 10 ft. along NW. slope.

29.98 Cor. No. 7, Ruth Ruble Placer, Mineral Survey No. 234, identical with cor. No. 3, Horseshoe Lode, Mineral Survey No. 840, monumented with the decayed point of the original wood post, size indeterminate, loosely set in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 1 ft. high, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Lancaster:

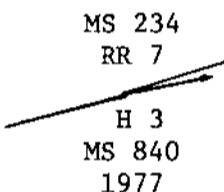
A decayed fir stump, 12 ins. diam., bears  
N. 53° 40' E., 35 lks. dist., no marks visible.

An alder root crown, size indeterminate, bears  
N. 33° 07' W., 32 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A cottonwood root crown, size indeterminate, bears  
N. 21° 22' W., 34 lks. dist., no marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.



from which new bearing trees

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 81 3/4° E., 9 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. MS 840 H3 BT.

A cedar, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 72° W., 28 lks. dist., mkd. MS 234 RR7 BT.

Deposit decayed point of wood post alongside iron post.

Corner is located at foot of mountain on southerly edge of placer tailings, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.

N. 62° 45' E., on line 7-8 of Ruth Ruble Placer, Mineral Survey No. 234.

Ascend 30 ft. along gentle NW. slope, through young timber and dense undergrowth.

11.315 Cor. No. 8, Ruth Ruble Placer, Mineral Survey No. 234, monumented with the remains of the original corner tree, a sawed and decayed cedar stump, 36 ins. diam., with scribe marks RR8 234 visible on partially open and weathered blaze on NE. face.

At the corner point

Drive an iron rod, 18 ins. long, 5/8 in. diam., 18 ins. into center of stump.
