No. 2, Horseshoe Lode, Mineral Survey No. 840, located on the eroding left bank of Coyote Creek, monumented with the decayed point of the original fir post, firmly set, in a mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, from which the remains of an original bearing tree:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A sawed fir stump, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 59° 10' W. 14 1/2 lks. dist. with scribe marks 40 BT visible on opened blaze. 12.33	<p>Intersect line 9-10 of Ruth Ruble Placer, Mineral Survey No. 234. No permanent monument established.</p> <p>From this point, cor. No. 9, Ruth Ruble Placer, Mineral Survey No. 234, bears S. 37° 34' W., 14.25 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.</p>
