A root hole, bears S. 42° E., 17 lks. dist., with a down madrone alongside, 16 ins. diam., no marks visible.

A madrone, 34 ins. diam., bears N. 64° W., 50 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A black oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 60° E., 37 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 12° E., 31 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 11° W., 26 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A root hole, bears N. 7° W., 53 lks. dist., with a down pine alongside, 28 ins. diam., no marks visible.
