A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N, 56° W., 34 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S19 BT. Descend 30 ft. over NW. slope.
30.50	Ravine, drains N.; asc. 215 ft. over NE. slope.
40.33	The 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 30 only, perpetuated and recorded by John M. Powell, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1970, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE T32S R4W 1/4 S19/S30 1970, from which the remains of the original bearing trees A fir, 57 ins. diam., bears N. 11° E., 132 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze. A roothole, bears S. 52° W., 88 lks. dist. and bearing trees mkd. by Powell A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 6° W., 17 lks. dist., with healed double blaze. a fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 69° W., 9 1/2 lks. dist. with healed blaze.
