**CHAINS**

From this point, the true point for the NW cor. of T. 23 S., R. 8 W., bears S. 89° 51' W., 8.60 chs. dist., described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 23 S., R. 9 W., executed concurrently under Group No. 1074 and this same group.

Land mountainous.  
 Soil, cly loam.  
 Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, myrtle, chinquapin; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, ocean spray, poison oak, rhododendron, salmonberry, and fern.

N. 1° 05' E., on the W. bdy. of sec. 31, marking and blazing the true line.

Desc. 95 ft. over NE. slope, through light timber and dense undergrowth.

- 4.35 Bottom of descent, slopes N. 40° E.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.
- 9.45 Top of ascent, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 285 ft. over NE. slope.
- 18.90 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 60° W.; asc. 405 ft. over SW slope.
- 36.90 Lutzinger Creek Road, gravelled, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 40° W., and S. 85° E. in curve.
- 39.13 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
