An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 11° W., 9 1/2 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. C48 RM 1981 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument bears N. 10° W., 8 1/2 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. T30S R4W S3 RM 1981 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

From this point, the NW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 49, bears N. 0° 08' W., 12.705 chs. dist., perpetuated and recorded by J. W. Cole, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1924, from original evidence no longer in existence, and further perpetuated and recorded by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1954, and 1963, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/4 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A sawed fir stump, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 61° W., 9 1/2 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Byron, in 1954

A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 40° E., 36 1/2 lks. dist. with healed double blaze.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 30 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

N. 88° 55' W., on the N. bdy. of Claim No. 48,
Ascend 155 ft. over broken SE. slope, through grain field.

3.57 From this point, the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10 bears South 0.49 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

23.52 From this point, the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10, bears South, 0.175 chs. dist., hereinbefore described. Also, leave grain field, edge bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W., enter scattering timber.
