88 lks. dist., with scribe marks 1/4 S8 BT  
visible on open blaze. (Record N. 8° E.)

A hemlock, 37 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 211  
lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks  
visible on partially healed blaze.  
(Record, S. 82 1/2° W.)

A yew, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 15 1/2° E., 58  
lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S8 BT.

N. 89° 54' W., bet. secs. 8 and 17.

Desc. 70 ft. over W. slope, through moderate timber and  
undergrowth.

1.10 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.

1.95 Little Camp Creek, 15 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc.  
325 ft. over rocky, NE. slope.
