CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary, subdivisional lines, and Donation Land Claim No. 37, and the subdivision of section 21, Township 29 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey is as follows:

The west boundary of the township was surveyed by Nathaniel Ford in 1854.

The south three miles of the west boundary of the township were retraced, and a portion of the subdivisional lines was surveyed by Dennis Hathorn in 1857.

Donation Land Claim No. 37 was surveyed by Dennis Hathorn in 1857.

The west boundary of the township and a portion of the subdivisional lines were retraced, the north boundary of the township was surveyed, and the survey of the subdivisional lines was completed by William H. Byars in 1881.

The east five miles of the north boundary of the township were retraced by William N. Gibb in 1910.

The west boundary of the township, a portion of the north boundary and subdivisional lines were dependently resurveyed, and section 3 was subdivided by Donald R. Beck in 1964-65.

A portion of the south boundary of the township and subdivisional lines were dependently resurveyed, and sections 9 and 33 were subdivided by John M. Jelley and Lynn M. Roseberry in 1966-67.

The boundaries of section 15 were dependently resurveyed and section 15 was subdivided by Bruce A. Shaner, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 430, in 1975, under Contract No. 52500-CT5-117.

A portion of the north and east boundaries of the township and subdivisional lines was dependently resurveyed by James J. Carlson in 1976.

The north one-half mile of the east boundary of section 24, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, and a portion of the boundaries of Donation Land Claim No. 37, were dependently resurveyed by Lynn M. Roseberry and James E. Jelley from 1967 to 1977.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the special instructions dated September 20, 1979, under Group No. 997, Oregon.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations, and refer to the true meridian.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original position. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. All lines not forming
