Shaner, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 430, in 1978, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/4 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A madrone stump, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 48° E.,
21 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks
visible on partially healed blaze.

A madrone, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 76 1/4° W.,
7 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks
visible on partially healed blaze.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 35° E., 119 lks.
dist., mkd. X BT.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 46° W., 157 lks.
dist., mkd. T29S R3W S5 BT.

S. 89° 37' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 5, marking and blazing the true line.
