A fir, 31 ins. diam., bears N. 9° E., 64 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 32° W., 77 lks. dist., with scribe marks 8S R3W visible on open blaze. (Record, 80 lks.)

- 19.30      Spur, slopes S. 25° E.; desc. 45 ft. over SW. slope.
- 28.15      Ravine, drains S.; asc. 55 ft. over SE. slope.
- 30.55      Spur, slopes S. 25° E.; asc. 5 ft. along S. slope, also enter logged area, edge bears N. 20° W. and S.
- 31.60      Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 50° E.; asc. 260 ft. over NE. slope.
- 42.88      The cor. of secs. 5 and 6 only, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., reestablished by proportionate measurement and recorded by Burton W. Holt, Registered Land Surveyor No. 418, in 1976, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/4 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 70 3/4° E., 56 lks. dist., with scribe marks T29S R3W S5 BT visible on open blaze.

A madrone, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 47 1/4° W., 40 lks. dist., with scribe marks T29S R3W S6 BT visible on bark.

Cor. is located on top of a spur, slopes S. 20° E., and in SW. cor. of a logged area, edge bears N. and S. 60° E.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay.  
Timber, fir, pine, cedar, madrone, hemlock, alder, and oak; undergrowth, salal, poison oak, salmonberry, arrowwood, dogwood, hazel, manzanita, fern, blackberry, and young timber.

- 3.50      S. 89° 47' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 6.
- Descend 80 ft. over SW. slope, through dense undergrowth and heavy timber.
- Ravine, drains S.; asc. 35 ft. over SE. slope.
