	A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 89 1/2° W., 25 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S6 BT. Descend 10 ft. over NE. slope.
40.85	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 65° W. and S. 75° E., in curve.
41.10	Beaver pond, 80 lks. wide, drains S. 35° E.; asc. 500 ft. over SW. slope.
65.49	The cor. of secs. 5 and 6 only, on the N. bdy. of the Tp. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, yew, maple, fir, cedar, oak, hamlock, pine, madrone, ash, and alder; undergrowth, hazel, arrowwood, poison oak, fern, vine maple, manzanita, ceanothus, huckleberry, blackberry, salmonberry, and young timber.

	From the NE. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 37 (located in sec. 20, T. 29 S., R. 3 W.), monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. T 29 S R 3 W C 37 S 20 1977 from which reference monuments set and mkd. by Jelley and Roseberry An iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, bears S. 28 1/2° W., 268 1/2 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. C37 RM 1977, with an arrow pointing to the cor. An iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, bears N. 58 1/2° W., 300 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. T29S R3W S20 RM 1977, with an arrow pointing to the cor. N. 89° 54' W., on the N. bdy. of Claim No. 37. Ascend 325 ft. over broken SE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
29.065	The crossing closing corner of secs. 19 and 20, at intersection with the N. bdy. of Donation Land Claim No. 37, hereinbefore described. From this point, the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 20, bears S. 0° 13' E., 6.48 chs. dist.
