	GENERAL DESCRIPTION The portion of the township covered by this survey lies in Douglas County about 10 miles southeast of the town of Glide, Oregon. The northern portion of the township is drained by Little River which runs in a westerly direction through the township, with numerous other small drainages running into Little River. The main access to the area is via Little River Road which parallels Little River and numerous other gravel and dirt logging roads. Elevations range from about 1,000 feet above sea level along Little River to about 2,600 feet above sea level near the center of section 6.
